

### Challenges from a university perspective

Regulatory frameworks for programme approval - complexity and coherence at macro policy level (DHET, CHE, SAQA, Prof. bodies)

Curriculum responsiveness and relevance – what are we responding to and for what purpose? Need for differentiated, flexible approach

Shifting skills demands impacts on employability of graduates

Funding and effectiveness of and placement sites for experiential learning

Ad hoc external linkages often at individual/departmental level – not sustainable; need for systemic and institutional coordination capability
